# Scientia's Accessibility Statement

Scientia is committed to ensuring digital accessibility for everyone. We endeavour to provide web services that conform to AA level of the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG 2.1), where this is reasonably practicable. Scientia is committed to the continuous improvement of the user experience for all users and applying all relevant accessibility standards wherever possible.

Some older products will likely not adhere to WCAG 2.1. As we advance, Scientia will endeavour to make new products and releases comply with the guidelines.

## Services Accessible to Students, Staff, and Public

### Open Timetables

The current release, 1.0.2, adheres to WCAG 2.1. This version added a series of accessibility-focused improvements.

### Publish

The next release, 2.5, will adhere to WCAG 2.1 in the non-administrative areas of the application, accessed by the vast majority of users.

### Resource Booker

The next release, 3.1, will partially adhere to WCAG 2.1. It will add a series of accessibility-focused improvements to the non-administrative areas of the application, accessed by the vast majority of users.

### Student Allocator – *Student screens*

The web-based screens in the current release of SA, 2.3, do not currently adhere to WCAG 2.1.

### Scientia Web Server

SWS has a natural successor in Publish and Open Timetables, where Scientia's accessibility focus will be moving forward.

### Web Room Booking

WRB has a natural successor in Resource Booker, where Scientia's accessibility focus will be moving forward.

## **Services Restricted to Administrators**

### **Enterprise Foundation**

Only the Portal portion of EF falls within the scope of web accessibility requirements. Its current release, 3.15, does not adhere to WCAG 2.1.

### **Enterprise Activity Adjuster**

The current release, 1.3.3, does not adhere to WCAG 2.1.

### **Exam Scheduler**

Only the Portal portion of ES falls within the scope of web accessibility requirements. The current release of the Portal, 3.15, does not adhere to WCAG 2.1.

### **Student Allocator – Administration screens**

Only the web-based portion of SA falls within the scope of web accessibility requirements. The current release of SA, 2.3, does not adhere to WCAG 2.1

### **Exam Management System**

The current release, 1.2, does not adhere to WCAG 2.1.

### **Web Data Collector**

The current release, 2.7, does not adhere to WCAG 2.1.

### **Report Manager**

The current release, 3.10, does not adhere to WCAG 2.1.

### **Staff Workload Planner**

Only the web-based screens of SWP fall within the scope of web accessibility requirements. The current release of SWP, 2.3.2, does not adhere to WCAG 2.1.

## **Scientia Connect, SPDA, DET, EMIT**

These are Windows applications, which are not within the scope of web accessibility requirements. Scientia Connect does include a web front end for running integrations that does not adhere to WCAG 2.1.

## **SDB Audit Trail**

SDB Audit Trail is a Windows application and thus does not fall within the scope of web accessibility requirements.
